A day in the field...

0700	A quick breakfast and briefing on the day ahead from Coral Reef CPR Director and Lead Scientist, Dr Andy Bruckner
0800 - 1230	Two morning dives at our coral nursery sites to conduct essential maintenance
1300 - 1415	Lunch break with time for a quick dip or sunbathe
1430 - 1630	Back in the water- collecting coral fragments of opportunity to set up a coral table or rope frame. Counting and removing coral predators from the area to give remaining corals the best chance of survival.
1630 - 1800	Free time: enter the day's data and enjoy the beautiful lagoon and beaches around the island
1800 - 1900	Represent Coral Reef CPR and continue to learn more about conservation at our coral educational talk at the pool bar!
1900	Dinner and debrief
