

Important information regarding tickets:

- Ages 2 and Under free if on a lap
- Each dancer will receive a free ticket to sit with their family during the show
- If your dancer is in both shows or siblings are in both shows, you will purchase tickets for one show and get complimentary tickets for the second show
- If your dancer is in the first show for competitive numbers (Production and Sr Teams) and
 parents would like to watch, we will have a balcony reserved for parents to watch. You will
 not be receiving a complimentary ticket for this show since they will be performing these
 dances again during the second show. You also have the option to drop off your dancer for the
 first show.
- Tickets will go on sale June 2 in our office. Families will be spaced out in the auditorium to
 ensure everyone's safety and to follow the guidelines set from Kent City Schools. Tickets are
 reserved seating and once purchased cannot be refunded. We urge people to buy tickets prior
 to the recital day to eliminate long lines and crowding.

Things to Know:

- Please have costumes for each dance. Please come dressed in your first costume.
- All dancers hair needs to be in a neat and secure bun (doesen't matter If it's high or low). If hair is too short Half up, half down
- Makeup optional
- We will be taking candid pictures of each dance / class and posting online for parents to have.
- The second studio will be a dressing room to change
- One parent per dancer allowed in the studio. Everyone must remain in a mask the entire time they are in the studio.
- For pictures we will put the class in a pose, have them pull their mask down and take a quick picture (about 20 seconds). If you would prefer your child keep their mask on, you can either tell your child or let us know right before we take the picture.
- If your dancer is not in a session, they must exit the studio so we can keep numbers down. No waiting around in the studio during sessions unless dancer is actively dancing.
- We will not run Production and Sr Comp teams twice even though they are performing twice
- We will do a Picture first followed by the routine rehearsing twice. We will run finale at the very beginning of every session. Once your child is done dancing in their session, you may leave.

RECITAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Date: Saturday, June 19, 2021 (No dress rehearsal) Location: Roosevelt High School Auditorium in Kent

- 1. All students must remain sitting in the auditorium with their family unless changing costumes or performing. No dancers will be backstage or socializing in the scene shop.
- 2. Students need to come dressed in their first costume and ready to perform.
- 3. Lineup for dances will be against the brick wall closest to the lobby. Please watch for your dancer's teacher to know when it's time for your child to line up. Your teacher will hold a sign with the name of the dance when it's time for that routine to line up. Student's will line up approximately 3 numbers before they dance.
- 4. Dancers will walk on stage, perform their routine and then exit the stage off the left side to sit with their parents.
- 5. There will be no intermission for either show and no concessions aside from water being sold.
- 6. We will be having a 50/50 raffle during both shows.
- 7. DRESSING AREAS the scene shop located directly behind the stage will be a dressing room to socially distance everyone changing. No boys and no Dad's allowed in this area. Boys may change in the boys bathroom located next to the scene shop. Dancers are not permitted to hang out in the dressing rooms these are for changing only and will not be monitored by any staff of the studio so parents will be responsible for their dancer.
- 8. Masks or shields are required for anyone sitting in the audience for the entire show. If we see audience members without masks, we will stop the show until all masks are put back on for the safety of everyone. These are not our rules these are the City of Kent's rules for us to be able to rent the auditorium.
- Dancers will be required to wear masks the entire time including on stage we will hand your dancer a performance mask when entering the auditorium that they will wear for the entire show.
- 10. Since Soloists will be the only ones on stage, they are not required to perform in a mask. If opting to not wear a mask, you need to wear your mask until you are on stage and then you can take off the mask and put at the front of the stage and then when finished, you'll put the mask back on and exit the stage.

- 11. No flash photography during the show as it's a distraction to the dancers
- 12. We will have a professional videographer for the show Chris Baldwin. Please see video order form to place your order.
- 13. We will be handing out year trophies throughout both shows. Each dancer will also be receiving a participation ribbon at the end of the show after Finale.
- 14. When dancers are done with finale, we will have all dancers sit down on the stage and dismiss by row / age to eliminate crowding and to make sure all of our little dancers have parents to go to.
- 15. After each show, audience is to remain seated and we will dismiss by rows to eliminate crowds. Please exit the school immediately when dismissed because we have to sanitize for the next show and you can take pictures and socialize outside.
