



NOTIFICATION OF ON-SITE STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Terms used in this document:

“In-person instruction” refers to a traditional congregate setting with face-to-face teacher-led instruction that occurs in a physical classroom.

“On-site learning opportunities and support services” or **“on-site support services”** means targeted support services offered directly to students when the school is not open for in-person instruction.

“Distance learning” means the delivery of instruction to students who may not be physically present in a school building. This may include synchronous or asynchronous lessons provided through online instruction, delivery of instructional materials and supplies, independent study, or project-based instruction.

On-Site Student Support Services

Per the Governor’s Executive Order, on Monday, August 17, 2020, Paulden Community School will begin offering free on-site support for the most vulnerable, high-risk students in our school who need a place to go during the school day while completing their online learning. This includes children of first responders, those with special education services, English Language Learners (ELL) or homeless and foster care students.

These services are available to all student during any **100% all-virtual learning status** (Substantial Community Spread) and to students who elected to attend virtually during a partial school opening, or **Hybrid learning status** (Moderate/Minimal Community Spread).

Please be reminded, on-site support does NOT include in-person instruction by a certified teacher but rather a location for our most at-risk students who do not have Wi-Fi or Internet service at home, or who do not have a safe place to go during the school day. All CDC and ADHS health guideline must be followed: at-home wellness check before leaving for the school; a face mask must be worn while on campus; social distancing must be practiced; and good hygiene followed especially frequent hand washing/sanitizing.

To sign up for on-site resources, registration must be completed by 4:00 PM on Fridays to access the support services for the following week.
