

Dynamic Perception Dance Company Dynamic Distance Learning

OVERVIEW

Dynamic Distance Learning (DDL) at DPDC has been designed as a response to our community needs due to COVID-19. DPDC will be offering students & families in our community additional support during these changing times. Our faculty will provide supervision, motivation, and positivity to each student to help them achieve their educational goals.

Led by the DPDC staff, Distance Learning will provide an opportunity for students to complete their required remote learning, as well as participate in special workshops, projects, and dance classes. Each learning space will have a mentor to monitor children through their day.

Dynamic Distance Learning is offered on a full day or half day monthly program, in order to fit their learning requirements outlined by their school.

DPDC does NOT supply snacks or lunches. All food must be brought with the student at the beginning of the day. Please plan to send 2 snacks and a lunch each day.

ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

DDL has 4 options for enrollment to fit each family's needs for this coming school year:

- 5 full days 8:00am-3:00pm
- 3 full days 8:00am-3:00pm
- 5 half days 8:00am-11:00am OR 12:00pm-3:00PM
- 3 half days 8:00am-11:00am OR 12:00pm-3:00PM

LOCATION

Dynamic Distance Learning will be held at Dynamic Perception Dance Company.

ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS

Dynamic Distance Learning at DPDC is open to students:

- Currently enrolled in Kindergarten – 12th grade
- Have an electronic device & headphones for remote learning
- Are enrolled in a remote learning program (DPDC will NOT be providing the learning/curriculum)

CLASS SIZE

In order to maintain proper social distancing, students will be separated into groups of no more than 14 per space. Groups will be determined by age. All students will have the opportunity to socialize at various times throughout the day.

STAFF

Dynamic Distance Learning will be supervised by staff members from Dynamic Perception Dance Company.

TUITION

All tuition will be charged at the beginning of the month. There must be a credit card on file for all DDL students.

No Refunds will be given for days missed and no make ups will be available.

There is a 30 written notice required for all students that withdraw from the program. Parent is responsible for the tuition for this 30-day period.

REGISTRATION

We encourage advance registration in order to guarantee your child’s spot(s) in the program. There will be a wait list created. Once a student has chosen one of our four options, they must stick to that option through the entire month. If a family needs to move from one option to another, they may do so only if room allows and at the beginning of the next month.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

A sibling discount will be applied for families enrolling more than one child at a rate of 20% for siblings.

START/END DATES

Classes will begin on Monday August 31st and end on Friday May 28th.
