A motion to pay all bills was made by Mykola Myronowskyj and was seconded by Andrew Bellone Jr.

The Wells Fargo payment for the KME will be sent on time avoiding the late fee.

5. Treasurers Report

Please refer to the attached report.

A bill to Glenn Insurance for the auto policy was missed during the last billing period. This was most likely due to the election and reorganization of the Board. Mykola Myronowskyj spoke to Kelly at Glenn insurance and explained the problem. The late payment will be issued at this meeting and Joseph Scapellato will hand deliver the check to the insurance company first thing in the morning. This will avoid a lapse in coverage.

The check issued to Charles Paladino was returned as the payee was listed incorrectly. This error was corrected, and a new check was issued.



5. Treasurers Report continued

PO number 119151 in the amount of \$7,915.00 was issued on 01-22-19 for the purchase of the ram. This purchase should have been made in December and taken from the 2018 budget. Mykola Myronowskyj spoke to Ed Paul regarding this mistake. A corrective solution is to have the funds allotted from future capitol instead of the equipment budget line item in 2019. This will allow the proper budget figures for this year and can be corrected during the audit next year.

A motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Samuel Scapellato and seconded by Mykola Myronowskyj.

6. Old Business

The Commissioners were reminded to check and clear their mailboxes each month.

The petty cash fund in the amount of \$300.00 will be created. Mykola Myronowskyj will create the form and will purchase a petty cash lock box for the Board.

The CPI adjustment for this year's LOSAP award is 2.1%. This will bring the award value to \$1,543.54 per member. 27 members achieved LOSAP for a total of \$41,675.58 sent to be sent to VALIC for LOSAP payments to the members.

Mykola Myronowskyj reached out to George from VALIC and a meeting for members to review their individual accounts is scheduled for 04-0-19.

The MUA's between the Board of Fire Commissioners, District 4 and the City of Bridgeton were confirmed received by the city clerk. A copy of the MUA was provided to the Chief, and the original will be kept on file in the Commissioners office.

7. New Business

The Board received an e-mail that VALIC will be changing its name to AIG. This notice will be shared to all fire company members.

NJ DCA Financial Disclosures will be due next month. As soon as the DCA sends the notification that the disclosure forms are ready, the Board members will meet at the office and Mykola Myronowskyj will assist them with the completion of their forms.

The FGVFC membership application has been updated to include the FDID forms. This new application replaced the old application on the website.



7. New Business continued

In a cost and materials savings initiative Mykola Myronowskyj suggested that fewer copies of the meeting minutes be printed and issued for review at each meeting. The minutes will be passed around and reviewed by each Board member, once the minutes are approved, they are put on the website. All Board members agreed. That 3 copies will be printed, 1 each for the Secretary for the file, the Chairman of the Board and the Fire Department meeting copy.

The new Board of Fire Commissioners District 4 office is still under construction. Once the new office is completed, the Board will have its meetings in the meeting room instead of the office. This will allow for a more open and public forum for our public meetings.

Mykola Myronowskyj suggested a change to the meeting minutes. Currently we have section 4 bills against the Commission and section 5 Treasurers report. Combining the 2 sections will better streamline the meeting process and will consolidate the information under 1 heading.

8. Public Comments Chief of the Fire Department:

The Chief forwarded Mykola Myronowskyj a request to have the following purchases approved.

- 1. Purchase of up to 10 fire pagers to replace the failing and defunct pagers. The Board approved the purchase up to \$3,130.00.
- 2. Purchase of up to 6 quick detach SCBA regulator hoses. The hoses are \$747.14 each. These hoses are used in the event that a fire fighter needs to connect their SCBA to another SCBA during a fire fighter emergency. The Board approved the purchase up to \$4,482.84.
