Vanara (Pre-K) – Teachers: Nandi Shetty, Girija Subramanian, Jagruti Patel

Children learned the shloka: "Om Ganapathaye namaha". They colored a Ganesha picture.

<u>Homework:</u> Practice the shloka and encourage them to talk about what they learned in class about Lord Ganesha.

Bala (Kindergarten) – Teachers: Shobha Umapathy & Amisha Amin

Students were told stories about Ganesha, his parents and how he got his elephant head, what he likes, etc.
