Happy New Year from Giles County Public Library! I cannot believe that it is already January again! Where did the year go? They always say that time goes faster the older you get. I guess when we have so many things going on each month at the library, it does seem that time flies! Here are some of the special programs and services that the library has for the next few months.

For our **January Art Show** this year, we will have watercolor art on display from our watercolor classes that started in October. The art classes have been very popular! We are continuing the classes with Caroline Bonner, a visual arts graduate from MTSU. If you would like to try it, just call the library and sign up. The next class is on January 10<sup>th</sup>. The spaces are going fast!

We are starting a **Kids Art Club** for kids ages 6 – 12 with Miss Elizabeth and Miss T'Kayah. The first date is January 18 from 3:30 – 4:30. It will be winter themed art for January. Call the library and let us know you are coming to have some creative fun.

**Bright Star Children's Touring Theatre** will be here again on Saturday, February 4, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. at FNB's Giles Heritage Theatre for **Black History's Groundbreaking Geniuses show**. This performance will be great for Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students to learn about amazing inventors, artists and thinkers from our history who changed the world, but all ages will enjoy the performances as well. Bright Star Theatre specializes in literacy, curriculum and character-education based performances. We are pleased to be able to offer this show to celebrate Black History Month. Mark your calendars. You will not want to miss this!

March is Quilt Month! The **March Quilt Show** is another wonderful way to display beautiful art. We would love to have a wonderful collection of quilts to display. We will start collecting quilts February 14th and continue through the end of February. The quilts will be on display the whole month of March.

It has been a year since the **James Webb Space Telescope** launched on Saturday, December 25. The first images from the telescope were captured in July 2022. As a host of the launch and first images events, the library receives a Community Engagement Newsletter with updates about the telescope and what it is seeing. Our new **STEM/STEAM Club** for teens is going well on the third Thursday of each month in the library starting at 3:30. It is for ages 9-16. We are doing hands on experiments and projects. We also have thirteen different **STEM kits** for check out to parents and teachers.

April is National Poetry Month and we are having an **Evening of Poetry with**

**Johnnie J. Tucker** on April 18<sup>th</sup>. We hope to have some local poets to participate also. If you write poetry and want to participate, we would love to have you come by and sign up for our **Evening of Poetry**.

**Kanopy** is up and running for our patrons of Giles County Public Library! We have joined **Kanopy PLUS** streaming service for libraries for our patrons. Our library patrons are able to stream a curated selection of movies and TV series for free in the Easy Watching category. To access Kanopy from our library, you will have to go to Kanopy on the internet and find our library. Then you will need to put in your library card number and PIN/password. You can stream Kanopy from a variety of platforms: Desktop, Apple TV, Phones (iOS and Android), tablets (iOS and Android), Chromecast, Samsung Smart TV, Roku, Fire TV, Fire Tablet, and Android TV. We are excited to be able to offer this service and we hope all of our patrons are taking full advantage of it!

**Ask a Librarian/Tech Help program** is going strong every Wednesday. If you would like help with your phone, tablet, laptop, email, etc., call and sign up for an appointment with a library staff member.

**Story Time, Lego Club, and Dungeons & Dragons** are still on the regular schedules. The calendars with all programs are included in this newsletter.

As a reminder, all of our library patrons have access to the **Consumer Reports Database** with your library card number to log in. From this database you can get product information, reviews and news on everything that Consumer Reports has to offer. Come in and get a library card if you don't already have one to be able to access the Consumer Reports database. It has a lot of good information!

**The Tennessee Electronic Library (TEL)** is also a valuable resource for Tennesseans to use for free. Tennesseans now have access to the full archive of the Tennessean newspaper through TEL. The Historical Newspapers: Nashville Tennessean now contains papers from 1812 – 2009. Recent Newspapers: Nashville Tennessean starts up from 2010 to the current week. You can access TEL resources from any computer with Internet access in Tennessee.

Also, don't forget we have **Wi-Fi hotspots** and **Chromebooks** available for our library patrons to check out.

Follow us on Facebook and Instagram to see what is going on at the library. We also have events in the Pulaski Citizen newspaper every week and on WKSR. Or come to the library and pick up flyers on all the events we have going on.


