My name is Billy Cannon and I will be the Autocross Event Director for 2017. Tony Ellison will be the Autocross Master in charge of designing a fun and challenging course. Billy Bruce and Raymond Paul will be Autocross Staff Experts. If there is anything that we can do to make this autocross a great day for you, then please let us know.

DIRECTIONS TO THE COURSE:

We will be using the smaller city parking lot for trailers and the staging area. This is the parking lot on your RIGHT after you go past the Festhalle and cross the river on Edelweiss Strasse. The parking lot on the LEFT will be used for the Autocross course.

INFORMATION:

Your Registration Packet & Inspection Sheet will be at the staging parking lot on Friday morning. The inspection sheet is available for viewing and printing on the website. If you know anyone who is NOT registered but wants to race, please direct them to the Festhalle to get registered.

Since the City parking lot we are using for staging is the smaller of the two lots, we ask that, if your car is street legal (has a tag), then please leave your truck & trailer in your hotel parking lot and drive your car to the staging lot.

8:30am - We will start setting up the equipment and course. Any help is appreciated.

9:00am – Mandatory Car/Driver Inspections. Driver must be present.

10:00am – Mandatory Drivers Meeting for all drivers and workers.

10:00am – Test & Tune (FUN) Runs.

11:30am – 12:00pm. We will break for Lunch.

12:00pm – 1:00pm – Lunch

1:00pm - Start the 4 Timed Competition Runs by group.

If time permits, we will then have fun runs for a bit.

- ___ 1. **HELMET** - DOT/<10yrs.
- ___ 2. **SEAT BELTS/HARNESSES** – Must be present and adequate. Where installation is other than factory design, the belt mounting must be securely anchored.
- ___ 3. **PEDALS** – Free return and in good operating condition. Firm brake pedal.
- ___ 4. **LOOSE OBJECTS** – Remove all loose items from trunk and interior.
- ___ 5. **GAS CAP** – Gasket intact and cap tightened.
- ___ 6. **TRUNK LATCH** – Must be fastened securely.
- ___ 7. **WHEEL BEARINGS** – Correct adjustment, check for play and proper lubrication, no damaged or burnt bearings.
- ___ 8. **BRAKES** – Must be tested for pedal "fade" while vehicle is stationary. Brake pads and/or linings should visually be adequate for an autocross type event.
- ___ 9. **WHEELS** – No cracks. No bends. All lug nuts must be torqued, Snapon wheel covers and trim must be removed from steel wheels.
- ___ 10. **TIRES** – Must be free of visible sidewall cracks
- ___ 11. **BRAKE FLUID** – Level up, must show in reservoir.
- ___ 12. **BATTERY** – Securely fastened and in good condition. No acid leaks or corrosion.
- ___ 13. **CARB BREATHER(s)** – Must be in safe condition and securely mounted.
- ___ 14. **THROTTLE RETURN** – Freely operating and with good springs.

All cars must adhere to the rules as defined by the SPRINGFEST Autocross Officials
