
There seems to be an increase of burning materials other than yard waste within The Village Limits.

Please note that Sheridan Village ordinance prohibits the burning of anything other than yard waste. Yard waste consists of leaves, grass clippings, fallen branches, etc.

Village ordinance allows yard waste to be burned on private property only, during day light hours, and under the supervision of an adult. At no time shall it be lawful for trash or building materials to be accumulated or burned within village limits.

Notice to residents:

In recent months, the Village of Sheridan has received numerous complaints from residents in reference to chickens being kept in town.

This issue has been recently addressed by The Village Board and the following ordinance will remain in place:



Municipal Code of Sheridan, Chapter 21 prohibits the keeping of chickens, ducks, geese other fowl or farm type livestock within the village limits.

Violations of this code can include fines from \$150-\$750.
