#### Spencer Flooding:

I thought I would add a little about the flooding at Spencer for those that were not able to attend the Roundup. Almost everyone has stories to tell. A lot have heard the stories on the news. One very sad item was we lost a fellow IH member from Illinois who was at the show and tried to cross the flooded road and was swept onto the river and drowned, so please say prayers for his family. I have heard that 40% of the homes in Spencer are damaged, 2 elementary schools will probably not be able to be used the entire school year this fall. There were only 2 hotels not affected by water, rest will take 6 months to renovate, 2 gas stations were not damaged in town. Due to locations of most restaurants I don't believe many if any survived not being totally damaged. Last I knew 2 churches and the fairgrounds are being used as shelters, with meetings being held on the fairgrounds to assist the citizens. The north parking lot is being used as dumping site for appliances and other debris. So while some of us were affected by the flood, none of us are going through what the citizens of Spencer are going through, but I imagine some of us have experienced some natural disaster in our past so we can relate to them. Please keep the citizens of Spencer in our prayers for them to have a safe and speedy recovery from this disaster.
