attended! Thank you again to Aerie President Eric Kelm for presenting the cake from the Aerie Brothers.

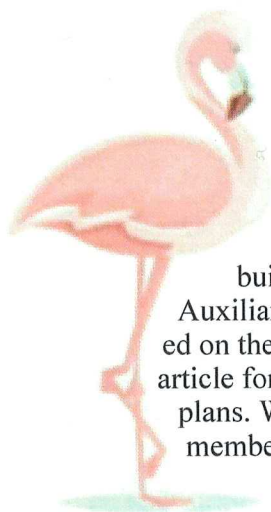

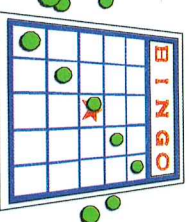

And lastly, the amount of places we will payout will depend on the amount of players.
