
March 11, 2018 Fourth Sunday of Lent John 3:14-21

"Whoever believes in the Son of God will not be condemned,

but he who does not believe has already been condemned." Nicodemus was a Pharisee, a group of Jews who studied the Law of Moses and the prophets and believed in the resurrection of the dead. Nicodemus was interested in Jesus because of what he did and what he taught. But because he was a member of the Sanhedrin, the ruling body of the Jews, he met with Jesus in secret. He wanted to learn from Jesus, but he did not have the courage to openly associate with him. That did not stop Jesus from meeting with him to help him grow in his understanding and love of God, and to reveal his mission to die and rise from the dead as a guarantee of life eternal with God who loves us. Are we sometimes reluctant to be associated with Jesus? Do we "Go along to get along!" rather than proclaim the beliefs and values of our Catholic faith? Or do we proclaim our faith in Jesus in the face of those who ridicule, reject and abuse us because of our Catholic faith? Lent is a good time for us to reflect on whether we are like Nicodemus, or are we a bold follower of Jesus?
