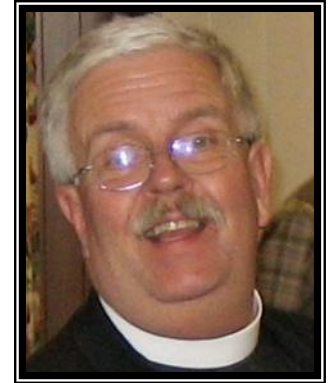

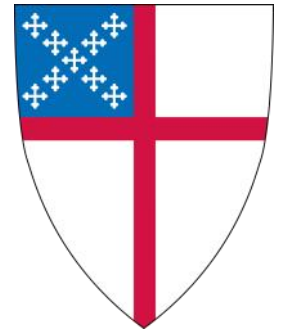

Annual Meeting

Thank you to everyone who braved the extreme cold to attend the Annual Meeting! And, we are SO grateful to Barb and Nancy, Janice & Steve, Cynthia Sorensen, and Nancy Gamby for a wonderful breakfast experience – from fragrance, to presentation, to taste, it was just perfect! Even though we believe the turnout was at least a recent record, for those of you who weren't able to join us, you were certainly in our thoughts.



While the minutes from the meeting will be to you very soon, we thought it important to share the outcome of the election for Vestry members as well as who was elected as your Senior and Junior Wardens at the Vestry meeting following the Annual Meeting:

- Steve Baker, Chris Gamble and Margie Mason were elected to three-year terms, and Sky Suydam was elected as the alternate with a one-year term.
- At the Vestry meeting, Bobbie Gaunt was elected the Senior Warden and Janice Williford the Junior Warden.

Back to the Annual Meeting, and a few words regarding the proposed Bylaw changes. Following much discussion, the following was agreed upon by all:

- The proposed changes to the Bylaws will be distributed in a traditional edit format where it will be easier to see, track, and understand the change being proposed compared to how the Bylaw is stated today;
- Congregants will be asked to provide their comments/suggestions to the Vestry in writing;
- The Vestry will take into consideration all comments and subsequently prepare a final review document, again edited to track the changes from the original document;
- A meeting will be sometime during the summer months to vote on the proposed Bylaw changes.

The “Summer” meeting will also include an update on the budget as well as any other pertinent business. We will work with the Diocese to determine whether this can be officially considered a “Bi-Annual” meeting.
