Medicare's Open Enrollment Period (OEP) runs October 15th through December 7th every fall. During this time, you can make changes to your health insurance coverage, including adding, dropping, or changing how you receive your Medicare benefits.

Even if you are happy with your current health and drug coverage, Medicare's Open Enrollment Period is the time to review your current coverage, compare it with other available options, and weigh whether it will remain the best choice for you in the coming year.

Take Action:

1) Create a list of all the health care providers you see, the prescription drugs you take, and the pharmacies you use.

2) Review plan notices and/or contact Medicare to learn about your 2018 coverage options.

3) Contact your SHIP for one-on-one assistance reviewing your plan options for 2018.

4) Protect yourself from enrollment fraud by double-checking all offers made before enrolling, resisting pressure from plans or agents, and reporting suspicious activity to your local Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP).




Forand Resident's
