- Remaining current in your knowledge of content and pedagogy by utilizing professional resources

The table below gives examples of developmental characteristics (intellectual, physical, psychological, social & moral/ethical) of students for teachers to consider when dealing with your students individual needs.

Elementary	Middle School	High School
Please see the links to the right for levels Pre-K through 5	Prefer active over passive learning Want to learn about things that relate to "real life" Consider academics secondary to personal and social concerns Are often disturbed by body changes Are erratic and inconsistent in their behavior Challenge authority figures; test limits of acceptable behavior	Health risks increase (eating disorders, drug/alcohol use, sexual experimentation) Allegiance & affiliation shift from parents & teachers to friends & peers Self-esteem changes due to home & school life Argumentative & aggressive behavior become evident Higher levels of cognitive function develop
