 - i. Test scores and practical skills are same or better than previous traditional courses. Progress report of students is sent to the instructor of the course once per week but can be set up for different notification timelines.
 - ii. FF1/FF2 class has been completed in 4 months with good scores and practical assessments.
 - iii. Cost is \$20 per student or per key and go through SD Redbook Fund Adam Frick for access key and payment.
 - iv. Driver/Operator is available as well.
 - v. SDFM is looking at adding a general aviation FF (ARFF) class to the online options. Target audience would be FDs with a small airport in jurisdiction (i.e. Platte, Wagner, Winner, etc.).
 - vi. Nothing legislative at this time.
