

Cut and Paste It!

Overview

This simple cut and paste activity presents the student with six symbols, four of which begin with the target letter. The student is to paste the four symbols that begin with the target letter onto the spaces provided. Skills embedded in this activity include letter identification along with beginning sound.

Customize

1. Change the symbols presented for selection to reinforce instructional or thematic vocabulary.
2. Remove the two distracters from the choices provided so that all symbols begin with the target letter; this will ensure success at the most basic level.
3. Type the word above each symbol. Keep in mind that with the written word above each symbol, the skill assessed becomes matching as opposed to initial sound.
4. Pre-cut the symbol options and present them to the student if cutting is a problem for the student. If cutting is not a problem, then the student can both cut and paste.

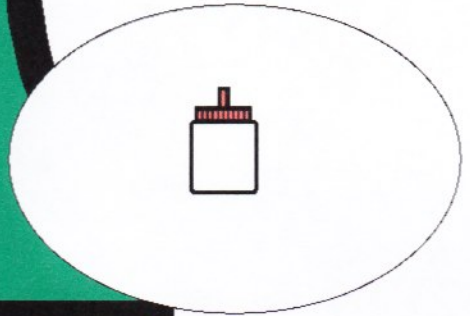
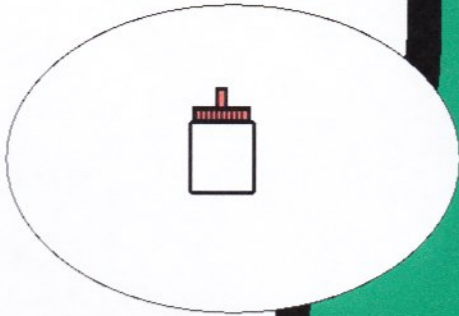
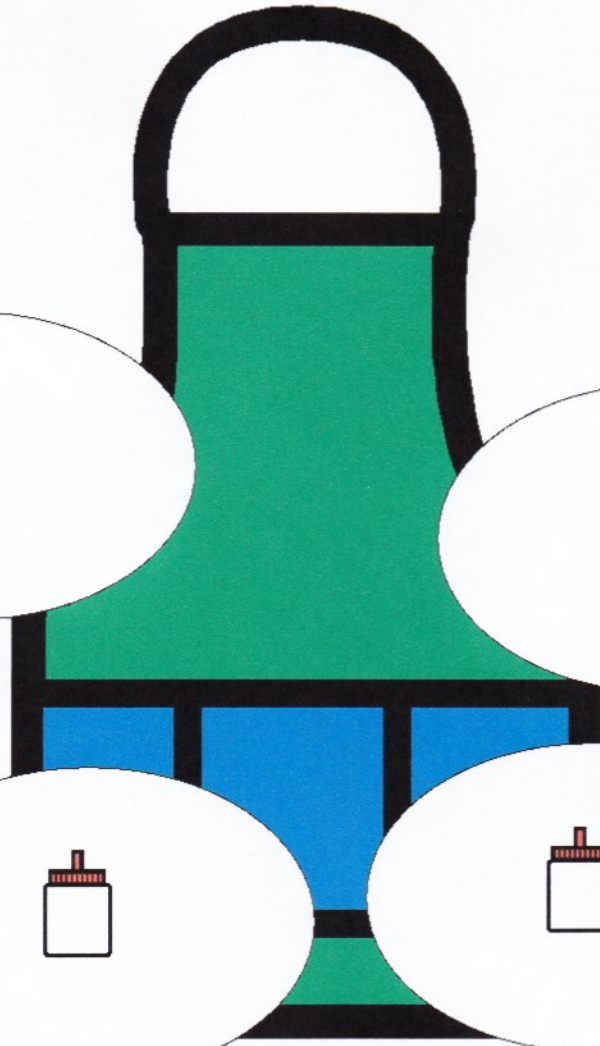
Extension Activities

1. Upon completing this activity for each letter, compile each of the worksheets into a book.
2. Present the student with two worksheets and all of the symbols on both of these worksheets. Have the student sort the symbols between the two worksheets and paste them accordingly.
3. On each of the worksheets the symbols are pasted onto a symbol of the same letter. For example, the "A" words are pasted on an apron. As a follow-up activity, present the actual object, i.e. an apron, and have the student sort or place the symbols onto or into the actual object.
