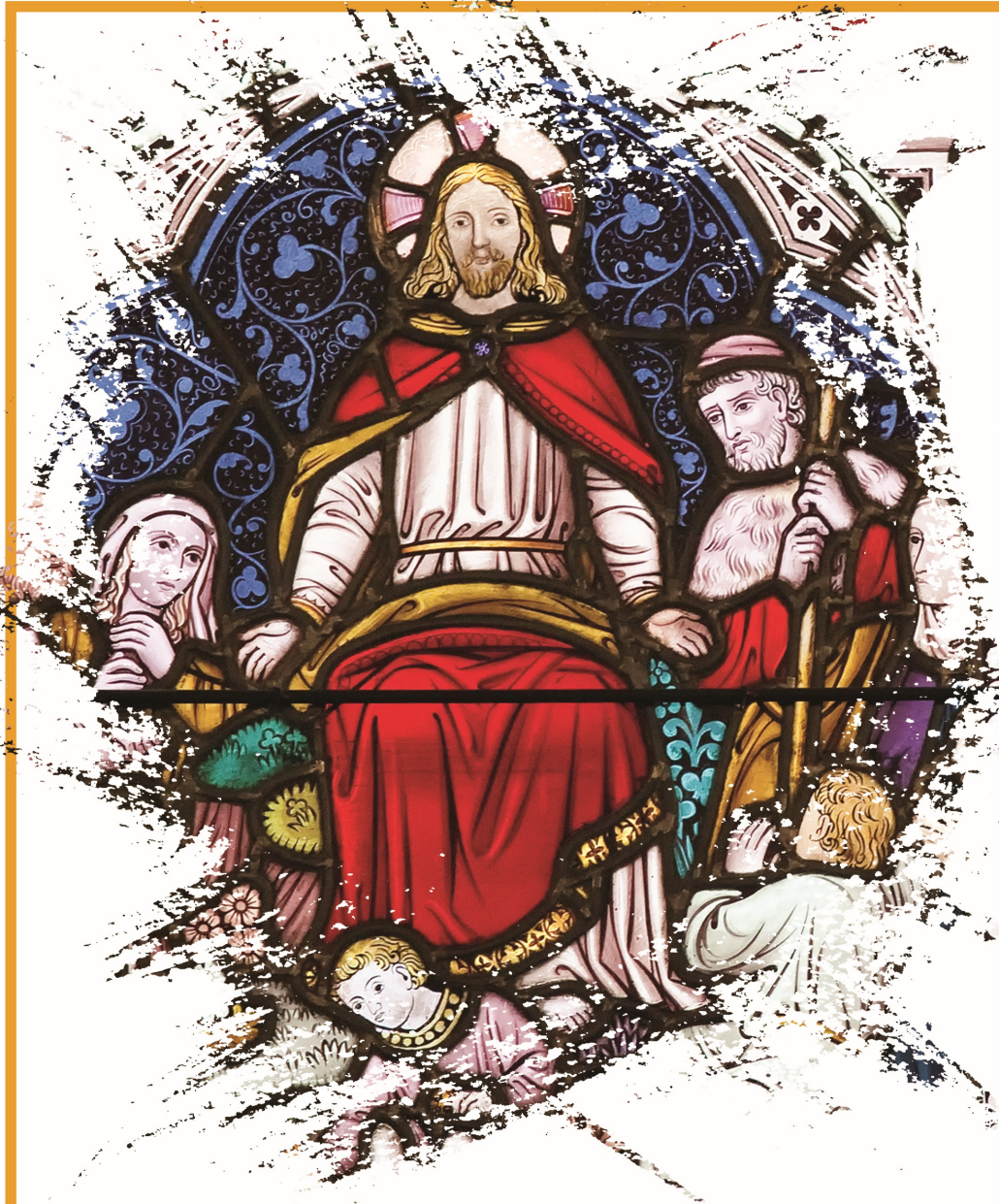

Why Combine Grades?

Instead of traditional grade, the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies combines grades to have four (4) levels:



Promise: Grades K & 1
Good News: Grades 2 & 3
Venture: Grades 4, 5, & 6
Visions: Grades 7 & 8

This program is able to combine grades like this because the lessons never repeat! Because Pflaum Gospel Weeklies are written new every year to follow the Lectionary and incorporate current events, the children won't sit through the same lessons multiple years in a row. And because children don't always learn at the same rate as their peers, they are able to learn at their own pace.

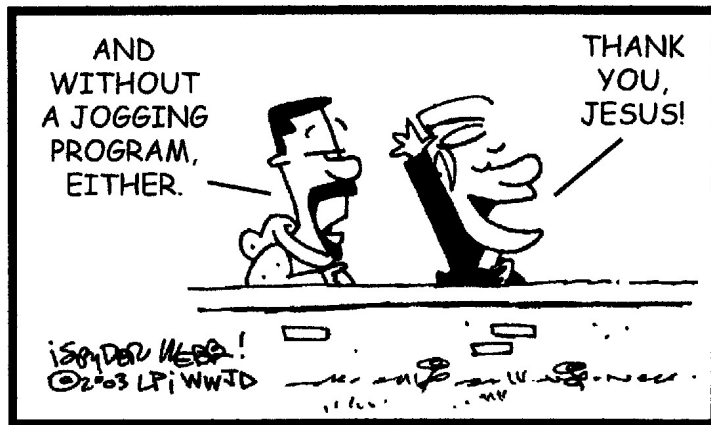
