## Solo Master Class Competition

### Competition Description:

The Solo Master Class Competition is open to all flutists currently enrolled in a college or university. There are two categories for this competition: Undergraduate and Graduate. The repertoire for each category is set, and applicants must record the selection from appropriate category listed below:

- Undergraduate Competition:  
Mozart Concerto in G Major, K.313, I. Allegro maestoso (**Exposition Only**) **OR**  
Mozart Concerto in D Major, K. 314, I. Allegro aperto (**Exposition Only**)
- Graduate Competition: Ibert Flute Concerto, III. Allegro scherzando (**Beginning to Rehearsal #61**)

*Applicants will be judged based on accuracy of rhythm, intonation, and technique and overall interpretation and musicianship.* The winners will perform the selected repertoire for the 2019 guest artist, Sharon Sparrow, in the Solo Master Class, on April 27, 2019. The master class is open to all registered festival attendees.

### Competition Requirements:

- Recordings must be emailed and registration forms & payment must be postmarked by 5:00 pm on March 1, 2019):
- The recording must be **unedited**. *Edited recordings will be disqualified.*
- Do not speak or make any identifying sound on your recording.
- Previous winners are eligible to participate.

### To Submit Your Recording:

1) Email your recording in MP3 format to [louisianaflutecompetition@gmail.com](mailto:louisianaflutecompetition@gmail.com) no later than 5:00 pm on March 1, 2019.

- In the subject line of your email, enter LFS 2019 SOLO MASTER CLASS COMPETITION.
- In your email, include your name as you prefer it to be listed in the program.
- List the school and program (Undergraduate/Graduate) in which you are currently enrolled.
- List repertoire selection.

\*To be eligible for the Solo Master Class Competition, you are required to be a member of the Louisiana Flute Society. Registration for the festival will pay annual membership dues. Materials submitted after March 1 and/or without payment will not be considered.
