September Block of the Month: Spools

Materials:

choose 4 spool fabrics;

from **each fabric** cut: 2 - 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares

3 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares


from background fabric cut: 16 - 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares

8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Construction:

Sort spool squares into 4 sets and choose one to begin with. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" background square. Match each 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" spool square with a background one, sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line, and cut apart on line. Press open and trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

Sew matching 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" background squares on either side of a 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" spool square. Sew 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" half-square triangle (HST) units on either side of a spool 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square, oriented so that the spool side match. Refer to diagram for proper positioning.



Sew strips together in a 3 x 3 configuration, making sure that the HST units are in the upper and lower corners. Refer to diagram for proper positioning. Press and measure the spool blocks. They should be 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square at this point.

Repeat instructions with the other 3 sets of spool sets. Sew the completed spool blocks together so that the bottom of one side abuts the side of another in a 2×2 configuration. press and measure finished block. It should be $12 \cdot 1/2$ ".

Remember your 1/4" seam allowance.

You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
