## 2014 Pentwater Sportfishing Association Ladies' Classic

The weather was the challenge this year as the big salmon stayed wherever they have been hiding and wherever the water temps are better. So the ladies headed out on the 12<sup>th</sup> PSA Ladies Classic with good fishing water and sunshine flavored with very cool breezes. Fish numbers were down but excitement remained high at the Pentwater Village Marina at the weigh in and the potluck that followed. When the tally was complete, some very happy faces told the story.

Thirteen boats tried their luck and practiced Rule #1 – Have Fun! A total of 51 fish had the net put to them by the ladies and those fish added up to 325.75 lbs. of fresh fish. There was a change in the Big Fish as a handsome 12.6 lb. Steelhead took top honors this year. Usually King Salmon are top dog, but no big salmon were boated this year. Here is the breakdown by species:

**King Salmon** - 7 fish totaling 37.6 lbs.

**Coho Salmon** - 3 fish totaling 9.95 lbs.

**Steelhead Trout** - 27 fish totaling 200.10 lbs.

**Lake Trout** - 14 fish totaling 83.10 lbs.

There is a Brown Trout category, but none were boated. Great job, Ladies!

Pictured below is the winning team from the Highway Boat, with skipper Darryl Highway grinning broadly in the background. A Steelhead trout weighing 12.60 lb. was the **Big Fish** this year for the entire Pentwater Sportfishing Association Ladies' Classic tournament and for Linda Highway on the right below, her first year of fishing the tournament. Besides the **1**<sup>st</sup> **Place** trophy were many gift certificates and some money too!



Pictured below is the Producer Fishing Team accepting the 2014 Ladies' Classic **Second Place Most Fish** trophy, for 10 fish weighing 57.55 lbs. The returning 1<sup>st</sup> place Big Fish champs from last year happily settled on second place and will eat hardy!

This year, the Mystery Weight was 6.1 lb. and the prize was snapped up by the Bad Habits team, Captainette Sharri German, with an exact weight of 6.10lb. Sharri is holding the trophy, and her fishing team Sue Jackson on her right and JoJean Eastman on her left. Cash prizes were included for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners this year. Dave and Sharri German, Northport Nailer Inc, donated the trophies this year and other years, so it was only fitting that Sharri and team won one of them to take home!!



After the first three places are determined, each **Biggest** of the five species (King and Coho Salmon, Lake, Brown and Steelhead Trout) earn a handsome plaque.
