Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ before returning to Ordinary Time next weekend. We celebrate the Blessed Sacrament and its importance in our lives and faith. Our readings today remind us of the covenant we share with God through the Eucharist. The first reading from Exodus speaks of the covenant God made with the people of Israel. Our second reading from Hebrews extends this covenant to all people and finally our Gospel recalls the actions of the Last Supper when Jesus instituted the Eucharist – a summary of his life and ministry. This feast reminds us that it is Christ who feeds us each week; that when we come forward each Sunday to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, we are renewing our covenant to live as members of Christ's Body here on earth through our words and actions. How fortunate we are to have the opportunity to share in the Body and Blood of our Lord. For our part, it is also equally important that we show reverence and respect to the Eucharist at all times, remembering the great gift we are blessed to celebrate each time we gather.
