Best Generals:

This is a pure general ship event, with prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd based off win ratio & battle points will be used to determine any deciders

Best Painted / Presented:

The player with the highest number of Players Choice votes will win this award.



Down Under Pairings

Players will need to register for the tournament through http://downunderpairings.com/index.php as well as to register your list.

On the day you will receive your round pairings and at the end of the game enter your results in. For those who don't have a smart phone with the ability to use this application don't worry your scores will be able to entered in some cases by your opponent or manually entered by the TO's. If anyone has concerns please email the TO's.

Tournament Rules

Format: Warhammer 40,000 Matched Play

Army Composition: Battle forged, 2000 points & a maximum of **THREE** detachments.



THIS EVENT IS A SANCTIONED ITC EVENT. PLEASE NOTE THE NEW FACTION CATEGORIES WHEN NOMINATING.

IT IS ALSO BEING USED AS PART OF THE DOWN UNDER PAIRINGS CIRCUIT.

NB: Forgeworld unit/s up to **power level 31** allowed at the event. You must bring a copy of the rules to show your opponent on the day of the event for any Forgeworld models being used.

You may not use Index/legend datasheets that might not appear in your Codex (such as a Chaplain on Bike).

Publications in use: All current and in-print Warhammer 40,000 Index's, Codexes, FAQ and Chapter Approved from Games Workshop, <u>released on or before the 5th April 2021</u> can be used at this event. The only exclusion from this event is the new War Zone Charadon: The book of rust rules will not be used in this event.

Army Lists

Lists are to be uploaded by midnight on the 5th April 2021 to the Down Under Pairings application.

If using Battlescribe please ensure you do not include the unit rules in your list submission. **Remember to include** any relics, warlord traits, basic psychic powers selected.

NB: Failure to upload your army list in a legible format, in time, <u>will result in player receiving a yellow card</u> sanction and a **2pt penalty** off your overall score.

Good Sportsman Conduct

At Briscon we expect every player to play within the spirit of the game. If there are any issues which players cannot determine for themselves please contact a TO. The basic rule being, "Don't be a dick and wear deodorant".

Briscon will be adhering to the ITC code of conduct rules (see link below). Any person found to be not adhering to these basic norms will receive sanctions. Sanctions ranging from a warning, to the issuing of a Yellow card. A player who receives 2 yellow cards is automatically given a red card and will no longer participate in the event. It is possible for a player to receive a straight red card. Persons participating on the DUP circuit will have any infringements noted for reference in future events and may lead to further sanctions.

Presentation Requirements

Briscon will be following the same Model Requirements for Events document published by Warhammer World. If a model does not meet this standard, the will don't receive the 10 points that is awarded for a fully painted army. At which point the Tournament Organiser will judge if they now do in fact meet the standard, and as such can be used for subsequent games.

If your army has heavy conversions or "counts as" models then you must seek prior approval from the Tournament Organiser. Models that are not clear as to what they represent may be requested to be removed from the table in the same manner as the painting requirements noted below and sanction/s applied, we strongly recommend checking with the Tournament Organiser first at warhammer40kbriscon@gmail.com



WYSSWIG rules will be used in this tournament.

Best Painted / Presented

When instructed you will be able to vote for your favourite army. **This will be done using the Down Under Pairings application.** If you don't have a smart phone you can inform the TO's (cards provided).

Mission Format and Scoring

Briscon will follow the ITC 9th Edition Guidelines found here. Please pay special attention to the ITC Code of Conduct: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1bUs0HrJ3f6YzR6mWlT1LRLq0i9 Oekf7ah9WhCTxslo/edit

Briscon will be using the **Missions** from the Warhammer 40k Chapter Approved Grand Tournament 2020 book. Missions will be determined randomly from these five over the weekend. These missions will be selected randomly and released to the tournament members 3 days before the commencement of the tournament.

NB: Players will be required to enter their overall score from their primary and secondary choices (if achieved) at the end of the game determining a winner and an overall score. For example, player A combines their scores to be 23 points and player B scores add up to 15 points. That is a score of 23 to 15 in A's favour and will be submitted and confirmed by both players on Down Under Pairings. The overall score will then determine the following round match ups.
