Today's indictments against Trump campaign manager, Paul Manafort, and his business partner, Rick Gates, and the guilty plea by Trump adviser, George Papadopoulos, for his conspiracy with Russians about the election, mark a turning point in our resistance to the Trump presidency. Special counsel, Robert Mueller, and his team of prosecutors have lots more to investigate, but think about the plea deal for just a moment; as the NY Times wrote, "The plea represents the most explicit evidence that the Trump campaign was aware that the Russian government was trying to help Mr. Trump and that the campaign was eager to accept that help."

This week San Fernando Valley Indivisible continues our resistance, focusing on events that are all about fighting back. We have a phone bank on Sunday in Sherman Oaks, working to elect the Democratic ticket in Virginia: Ralph Northam as governor, Justin Fairfax as Lt. Gov., and Mark Herring as Atty. Gen. This election on Tuesday, Nov. 7, in Virginia is a critical bellwether test of Democrats pushing back against Trump. Winning here sends a message to Republicans across the country to stop supporting Trump. And more importantly, Dems

winning in Virginia means we can stop the gerrymandering in Virginia where Dems have been getting more votes than Reps but not getting as many Congressional seats.

Don't pop the champagne corks yet or think that Mueller's investigation will end the Trump presidency any time soon. The only way to get Trump out of the White House before the 2020 presidential election is to win the House and the Senate in 2018 and then impeach!
