

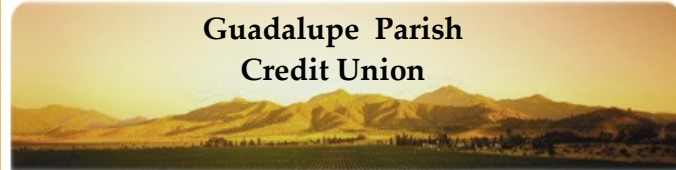

## MASS READING RELFECTION

Jan 12, 2020

Reading Is 42:1-4,6-7  
[Works of the Messiah]

It is not clear what kind of person the inspired poet had in mind when he depicted an ideal servant of God in the four "Servant Songs," as we have them in Isaiah. It is the whole nation of Israel? Is it some prophet or king of the past? Is it Messiah (Anointed King) to come?

Reapplied by the evangelists and the Church, the Servant is identified with Jesus, who is manifested as God's beloved Servant (Son) in his baptism. The song depicts what the Lord Jesus' mission is to all of us. Reapplied by the Church, the psalm refers to the voice of God "over the waters," when Jesus was baptized in the Jordan.

2nd Reading Acts 10::34-38  
[Anointed To Do Good]

Peter sees Jesus as in his baptism "anointed... with the Holy Spirit and power" and so equipped for his calling: doing good work and healing all who were in the grip of the devil.

A similar calling is ours as baptized Christian. Being a Christian does not mean just avoiding sin. We are anointed to do good and to be concerned about other human beings who are in the grip of evil. And God will be with you!

### BAPTISM OF THE LORD



### THEME: The Servant of Yahweh

*Every time we discover a new aspect in the person we love, we stop in wonderment. "I did not know him/her as such!" And this deeper insight and sharing in a person's self result in greater appreciation, intimacy, and love.*

*Today we celebrate the Lord's Baptism by John in the Jordan. Matthew relates Jesus' Baptism as another epiphany (manifestation), declaring that the Lord Jesus is the servant (Son) of Yahweh. His call in life is that of the Servant as depicted in today's first reading. This is an aspect of Jesus' personality which gives us a deeper insight into who our Lord is. He is "the man for others." He is there for you and me.*

*Experiencing this in prayer, we should appreciate and love our Lord more for it. We each have our own calling in life. We must respond to it in the framework of our personal capabilities and the circumstances of time and milieu. Serious and mature people understand that only a life of service is a meaningful life. What do you consider your main calling in life, and how do you fulfill it?*

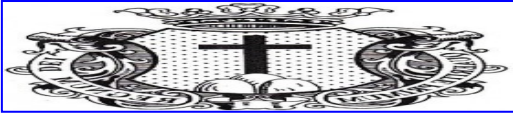
