

Dear Sylvan Lake residents,

Over the next 3-4 weeks we will be going through the process of dredging and repairing two of the four ponds in our neighborhood. The construction company will be working on ponds 1 and 2 (the two ponds closest to 159<sup>th</sup> street). During this time there will be heavy construction equipment, increased noise and you might see some unfamiliar faces of the workers.

To share a brief summary of the process, the construction team will pump the water out of pond 1 (smaller pond) and allow it to “dry out” for a few days. As the ponds are drying the team will focus on pond 2 and repeat the process. As the ponds are “drying” a different group will do the necessary repairs to the electrical and structural parts of the pond. The ponds will be dredged and the process is complete. The ponds will be filled naturally (rain).

During and after the construction please consider the following:

- Over the next week, feel free to move the fish from ponds 1 and 2 to ponds 3 and 4. This is a great opportunity to get out for some fishing.
- Stay clear of the construction equipment at all times.
- For your safety, when ponds are drained please do not enter the ponds.
- There might be some roadblocks at main entrance for brief periods of time.

This project is a necessary process in order for us to preserve and maintain our ponds and your patience is much appreciated.
