April, 2020

Doc: We are ~83% into the current year. All departments are in line.

Total expenses are at 55%. Revenue "in" at 71%. Property tax has finally moved forward to 100%. Interest coming in well.

Scott: Expenditures are under budget. Grant funding is still out. No expenditures yet, so no spending to be reimbursed for.

Doc: Unrestricted Funds @ \$4,061,716.39 and Restricted Funds @ \$973,307.47 for a Grand Total Fund Balance of \$5,035,023.86.
