which to devote 40 hours of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament with the emphasis on Vocations. Saint Olaf Parish has been assigned the days of February 18 - February 21 for this devotion. We have scheduled Adoration to begin on Sunday, February 18 @ 5:30 pm with solemn exposition and adoration prayer that will continue for 24 hours until 5:30 pm Monday February 19. Our 40 hour Adoration will continue on Tuesday, February 20, 8:30 am - 5:30 pm and conclude on Wednesday, February 21, 10:00 am - 5:30 pm.
