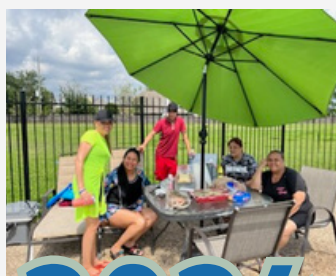
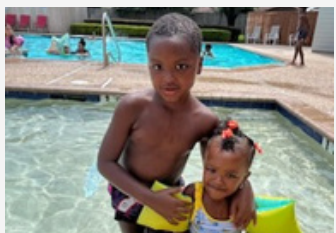
Laurel Oaks Annual Assessments

It is imperative that all residents pay HOA dues to ensure we can fund the continued safety, growth, and beautification of our neighborhood. Assessments are \$528 due on January 1st each year with a 30 day grace period. Fees are increased after January 30th and again after February 28th.
