

## Scholarship Application Form



West Wetaskiwin Rural Electrification Association (REA) provides 2 scholarships of \$1,000 each for children of West Wetaskiwin REA members. The selection of scholarship recipients is open to students in either diploma or degree granting programs. Additional considerations for acceptance include the applicant's community involvement, financial need and academic achievement.

To be considered for a scholarship, the applicant will:

- Be entering their first year of post-secondary study in a diploma or degree granting program.
- Be a high school graduate of the previous or current calendar year.
- Provide provincial transcript of marks for grade 12.
- Provide proof of registration in the post-secondary program of studies.
- Enclose a letter of reference from school principal, teacher or guidance counselor, with the application.
- Enclose a letter (essay style) from the applicant outlining the need for financial assistance, reason for choosing the program of studies and a description of the applicant's community involvement.

This application form, with required documentation, must be mailed to West Wetaskiwin REA, R.R. #1 Main, Wetaskiwin, AB T9A 1W8 postmarked on or before August 1st **of the year of application**.
