Jack George Aumann, 84 of Pigeon, passed away Friday, Oct. 27 at Four Seasons Health Care Center in Bad Axe.

He was born April 1, 1911 in New York to the late Henry and Vila (Smead) Aumann. He was united in marriage to Louise Facknitz on Sept. 28, 1936 in Bowling Green, OH. She preceded him in death in 1978.
