Registering Juniors in and out of Sessions

At junior training nights, children should present to the dug outs on the side of the pitch accompanied by their parents, where a member of the Junior Team in a pink bib will tick them off the register.

At this point any messages relevant to that child re: someone different picking them up, any medical concerns etc. should be communicated, and documented at the side of the register for that night.

Midway through each session the register needs to be handed over to one of the assistant coaches, when all the children have arrived.

At the end of the session the Head coach for that age group and other Assistant coaches gather with the children on the pitch and go back down the register, ensuring each child has been picked up safely by their parent, ticking them off.

Or another parent if this has been documented on the register for that night. If there are any doubts by the coach about who is collecting a child, or no one comes for the child then the Head coach/Junior staff reserve the right to call the parent to check before releasing the child from the session.
