ORDINANCE NO. 2018-07

**AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE ANNEXATION OF 1.7616 ACRES OF
LAND LOCATED IN WESTFIELD TOWNSHIP, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, TO
THE VILLAGE OF GLORIA GLENS PARK AND SPECIFYING THE
SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO SAID PROPERTY ONCE IT IS ANNEXED
TO THE VILLAGE.**

WHEREAS, the Medina County Park District has agreed to petition the Medina County Commissioners for annexation of a 1.7616 acres parcel of land in Westfield Township to the Village of Gloria Glens Park pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023, the Village will consent to said annexation and wishes to provide a list of services which will be provided to the property once annexed pursuant to R.C. Section 709.023(C) and (D);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLORIA GLENS PARK, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, as follows:

SECTION I: Village Council hereby consents to the annexation of 1.7616 acres of land from part of Westfield Township to the Village of Gloria Glens Park.

SECTION II: The services that the Village of Gloria Glens Park will provide to said property effective upon approval of the annexation by the Medina County Board of Commissioners are as follows:

- A. Police services as are provided by the Medina County Sheriff's Department to the Village of Gloria Glens Park under specific contract for the same;
- B. Fire and ambulance service as the same is provided to the Village of Gloria Glens Park by the Lafayette Township Fire District under specific contract for the provision of the same; and
- C. Water and sewer services as the same is provided to the Village of Gloria Glens Park by the Medina County Sanitary Engineer's Department, although at present no water and sewer service is provided or requested for said piece of property.

SECTION III: For zoning purposes said property will be designated as Park property and all use of the property shall be as determined solely by the Medina County Park District, or its successors and assigns.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall go into effect thirty (30) days after the date of its passage.
