The name of this scholarship, to be awarded annually, will be the "NKBMA/Gene Thompson Scholarship". The scholarship is available to all second year students who plan to graduate with either a diploma (38-48 Credit Hours) or AAS degree (66-76 Credit Hours) in the PSAM program at the Kentucky School of Bluegrass and Traditional Music.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The race, color, creed, gender or religious affiliation of the applicant will not be a factor in determining eligibility for this scholarship.
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled in either the PSAM Diploma (38-48 Credit Hours) or PSAM AAS Degree (66-76 credit Hours) program at the Kentucky School of Bluegrass and Traditional Music.
- 3. The applicant must have completed their first year in their declared PSAM program of study.
- 4. The applicant must have a 2.5 grade point average or higher.

TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP: This is a non-renewable, outright grant, awarded annually.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. One, \$1,000.00 grant to be disbursed as follows:
 - a. One \$500.00 grant installment to be paid at the beginning of each semester (one year only).
 - b. To be paid directly to the school at the beginning of the semester in which the student is enrolled.
- 2. Student must maintain at least a 2.5 average to be eligible for the second and final grant installment.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Applications must be received at the NKBMA Office by August 1st of the current year.
- 2. Applicants must provide three (3) letters of reference. One letter must be a recommendation from their music instructor or teacher.
- 3. Applicants must furnish a current transcript, including their most recent GPA, from the Kentucky School of Bluegrass and Traditional Music.
- 4. Applicants must furnish a copy of the latest 1040 Income Statement for their source of support (ie: self, parent(s), etc.)
- 5. Applicants will be required to state their reason for applying, including an artist's statement, financial need, college plans, and any additional pertinent data that may aid the Scholarship Committee in making their selection.
- 6. Applicants must furnish a recent photograph (black & white OR a color photograph with LIGHT background) that will be used for the sole purpose of publicity of the winning applicant for the association. Please note that photographs cannot be returned.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. All applications for this scholarship received at the NKBMA Office by August 1st of the current year will be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee.
- 2. Envelopes will have the receipt date written on them and will be attached to, and become part of, the application.
- 3. The Scholarship Committee will review and select the winning applicant based on the criteria as set out herein. Provided that all other factors being equal, the scholarship will be awarded to the individual who is otherwise qualified and is in need of the financial aid afforded by this scholarship.
- 4. The winning applicant will be notified by mail.
- 5. Funds will be disbursed on behalf of the Association through the KSBTM at Hazard, KY.
- 6. The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final and absolute.
