SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The scholarship application package must be received or postmarked by the posted deadlines, no later than February 28, 2019 for consideration. Items in the scholarship application package include:
 - a. Fully completed scholarship application
 - b. Official transcript
 - c. Three letters of recommendation
 - d. College or University acceptance letter, if applicable
 - e. Biographical statement
 - f. Two hundred fifty (250) word essay
- **2.** The fully completed **application** must be typed.
- 3. An **official transcript** including the school seal must be submitted as a part of the scholarship application package. For college students who are applying, an official transcript signed by the college or university registrar is required. All college or university students who are applying **must be full-time** students with twelve (12) or more credits per term/semester.
- 4. **Three letters of recommendation** are required. These letters must be typed on school or business letterhead. No handwritten recommendations or letters of recommendation on plain white paper will be accepted. The letters must include the person's name, title, address, telephone number and relationship to the applicant.
- 5. A biographical statement listing any community service activities, organization memberships, and other pertinent information must be submitted. The biographical statement must speak to your character, qualities, strengths, educational goals and career aspirations. The statement must be typed and double-spaced.
- 6. A two hundred fifty (250) essay, that gives reviewers additional insight about you not covered in other sections of the application. Write about how this award can help you achieve these goals. Why should you receive this award? Examples might be school, life or job experiences, community service/activities, special skills, talents, or your motivation for seeking a scholarship. The essay must be typed and double-spaced.

- 6. The Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Kappa Rho Zeta Chapter Scholarship is competitive. More applicants will apply than scholarships will be awarded and submitting an application does not guarantee funding.
- 7. All requested information and application packages must be **postmarked no later than February 28, 2019. There will be no exceptions.**
