Selection will be made before the beginning of Heritage Chorale's spring semester in January 2019. The scholarship award of \$1,000 will be made at Heritage Chorale's spring concerts in April 2019.

I also understand that this scholarship, if awarded to me, is for my pursuit of music study in the vocal arts, and that payment will be made to the institution(s) or individual(s) with whom I study in 2019.
