Then follows the Communion Rite,**

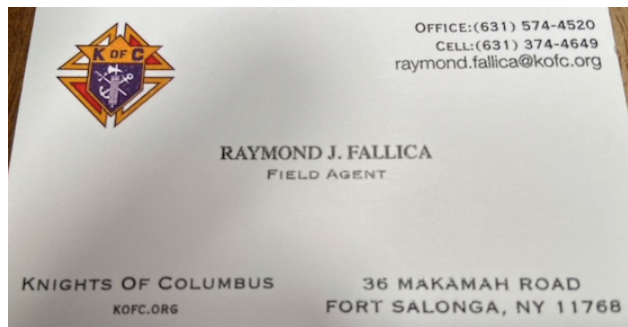
