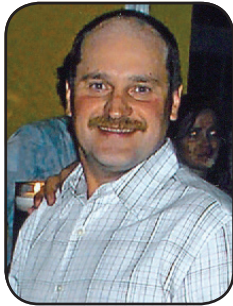


Lawrence "Larry" R. Popp, 51
