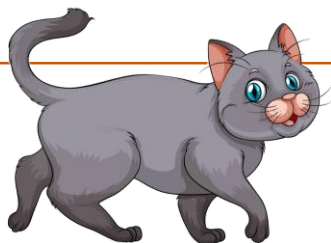



In the Woods




