# 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual CARDBOARD BOAT RACES on the ST MARY'S

MALETTE PARK, DeTour Village MI

### 1. BOAT DESIGN and CONSTRUCTION

- a. Boats must be made BEFORE THE RACE
- b. Boats must be made ONLY of cardboard and duct tape. NO reinforced cardboard tubes. Only broken down cardboard boxes.
- c. Cardboard cannot be sealed with any paint or sealants.
- d. Duct tape may be of varying colors for creativity.
- e. Boats may be a maximum width of 60" (5 ft) and a maximum length of 84" (7ft).
- f. There is not a maximum height requirement.
- g. Boats must be completely enclosed on all sides, or permit the crew to remain fully on top of the vessel.
- h. Boats must only be propelled by use of paddle and/or hands.
- i. Paddles will be provided if needed.

### 2. RACE FORMAT

- a. Boats will need to be designed to carry two individuals that will climb in from the top.
- b. Each person must wear a PFD (Personal Flotation Device). There will be PFD's on site if you need one.
- c. Participants must be 10 years of age or older.
- d. Each participant must sign a participant / parent waiver day of race. Parent signature required for minors.
- e. Teams consist of 2 individuals that will ride in the boat at the same time.
- f. Teams will start at marker closest to the shore, entering boats from a ladder next to starting marker.
- g. Teams will paddle out and around other marker and return to their starting location.
- h. Each team will compete for fastest time.
- i. If no team reaches the finish line before sinking, the team that stayed afloat the longest will be crowned winner.
- j. Once your boat is completely under water or an individual exits the boat, your time stops.
- k. The race must begin and end with the two – person crew intact.
- l. Each boat will travel roughly 80 feet (40' out and 40' back).
- m. Teams are responsible for removal of boat & (anything else they bring with them) from Malette Park upon leaving.

### 3. TEAM AWARDS

- a. Winners will be awarded to:
  - a. FASTEST BOAT
  - b. MOST CREATIVE BOAT

### 4. RACE DAY

- a. Held as part of DeTour Village Riverfest - AUGUST 3, 2019
- b. Held at Malette Park, DeTour Village, MI
- c. CHECK IN: 2:30pm RACE TIME: 3:00PM
