WENDOVER CITY RESOLUTION NUMBER 2019-09

A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE NOVEMBER 5, 2019 MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF WENDOVER, TOOELE COUNTY UTAH.

WHEREAS, Utah Law provides that a municipal legislative body may cancel a local election if all municipal officers are elected in an at-large election and the number of municipal officer candidates, including any eligible write-in candidates for the at-large offices, does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have filed;

WHEREAS, the two 2-year positions and the three 4-year positions open for election, are at-large positions and the number of candidates for these offices does not exceed the number of offices, for which the candidates have filed;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Section 20A-1-206 that the November 5, 2019 local election for the Wendover City Council is hereby cancelled and the City Recorder is directed to give notice of this cancellation as required by law. Gordon R. Stewart and Darlene Trammell for the 2-year positions and Ana Aboite, Manuel Carrillo Gomez and Dennis B. Sweat for the 4-year positions, are the only 5 candidates to file for the 5 seats, are hereby considered to be elected to the office of Wendover City Council to begin on the first Monday of January 6, 2020. RESOLVED AND ADOPTED by the Wendover City Council this October 3rd, 2019.
