



Learn to Skate (LTS) Parent Information Sheet

Wednesday night schedule

5:30-6:00	Pick up name tag and put skates on.
6:00-6:15	Free skate/Practice time (Private lessons available-inquire at LTS table)
6:15-6:35	Group lesson
6:35-6:50	Free skate/Practice time (Private lessons available-inquire at LTS table)

Private lessons are a great way to get some added instruction. This is 15 minutes of one-on-one time with an instructor. Privates cost an additional \$7 per 15 minutes. This is paid at the LTS table each week and the money goes directly to the instructor. After your first private lesson, if you wish to continue private lessons each week, we will reserve that time and instructor for the remainder of the session. Just stop and pay each week.

Groups/Levels (Snowplow 1-2, 3-4 Basic 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Freeskate)

Jamestown Skating Club Learn to Skate USA is a program of United Skates Figure Skating. The levels and individual skills taught at each level are all part of that program. Skaters will progress through those levels at different rates. Skaters will be moved to the next higher level only after they have mastered the skills at the current level. This may happen after one 7 week session or it may take longer. Skaters will be evaluated at or near the end of each 7 week session to determine if they will be moving up or staying at their current level. Practicing the skills during free skate is the best way to master them. If the skater does not move up, it does not mean they “failed”, it just means they need more practice on some or all of the skills at that level.

Requirements and Requests

All LTS participants must have a parent or guardian present at the arena during LTS.

- Gloves are a necessity.
- Helmets are required if your skater is 7 or under.
- Our instructors cannot accompany skaters to the bathroom. Please remain available should this become necessary. Remind them to go before they enter the ice.
- All skaters fall – even the very best. Don’t let them get discouraged but remind them to get back on their feet quickly. Blades are sharp and a skater on the ice is in danger of being hurt.
- Our instructors reserve the right to remove any skater from the ice if they feel they are a danger to themselves or others.
- Name tags must be left at the LTS table each week.
- Missed sessions cannot be carried into the next 7 weeks. If you miss a session, you may be able to make it up on a Saturday. (Only 1 per every 7 week session(s)) Please inquire at the LTS table.
