Thursday, December 22nd

#### Armed Forces Bowl in Fort Worth, TX

**1★ UNDER 43.** † Baylor 23 Air Force 17. 20 degree temperatures and 20-plus mph winds are in the forecast for this game and it's a big reason why the total dropped 4 points the other day. Obviously, that will impact Baylor in the pass game more than Air Force's triple option offense. The Falcons are led by FB Brad Roberts who ran for a school-record 1,612 yards and 15 TD's. Air Force led the nation in rushing averaging 331 ypg. Air Force's rush defense allowed just 47 ypg in their final 4 games. Meanwhile, Baylor limps in after suffering 3 straight losses. The Bears do have a massive strength of schedule edge (No. 25 vs No. 126). This is the first time all season Air Force finds themselves an underdog and Baylor is the best they've played. With defensive-minded Dave Aranda having extra time to prep vs the option, we think Baylor shuts down the option.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

### Friday, December 23rd

#### Independence Bowl in Shreveport, LA

**1★ UL-Lafayette (+7).** † Houston 31 UL-Lafayette 25. Houston is better in ypp margin (+0.68 vs +0.02) and played the tougher schedule (No. 62 vs No. 88) but are -8 in TO's (worst among bowl teams). The Cougars top WR Nathaniel Dell has declared for the NFL Draft but will play in this game. QB Clayton Tune (35-9 ratio) is also playing. Meanwhile, UL-Lafayette's top WR Michael Jefferson has opted out and QB Ben Woolridge is also out but Chandler Fields has 158 pass attempts on the season (10-4 ratio). Houston head coach Dana Hologorsen is a pathetic 2-7 ATS in bowl games and it's tough trusting a Houston defense that allows 34 ppg and 430 ypg including a 31-7 TD-to-INT ratio. Wind and cold temps are in the forecast.

#### Gasparilla Bowl in Tampa, FL

**1★ Missouri (+1).** † Missouri 30 Wake Forest 29. Wake Forest limped to the finish losing 4 of their last 5 games all as a favorite. Missouri actually has the better ypp margin and played the tougher schedule (No. 32 vs No. 61) so we're not surprised we've seen the Tigers take some money here. Wake QB Sam Hartman is likely playing his final game for the Demon Deacons (transfer rumors). Meanwhile, Missouri will be without their top WR Dominic Lovett (843 yards) and three defensive starters (DL Isaiah McGuire, DL DJ Coleman and S Martez Manuel). We'll defer to taking the points with an SEC team vs an ACC team.

### Saturday, December 24th

#### Hawaii Bowl in Honolulu, HI

**1★ San Diego St (-6.5).** † San Diego St 29 Middle Tennessee 20. Everyone remembers Middle Tennessee's shocking upset of Miami earlier this year as 25.5-point underdogs (biggest upset of season) but after that MT only covered 2 of their last 8 games and the Blue Raiders did not beat a single bowl team this year and were -240 ypg vs winning teams. Meanwhile, San Diego St turned their season around winning 5 of their last 7 and that includes a last-second loss to Fresno where the Aztecs blew a late lead. The best unit on the field is a San Diego St defense that allows just 20 ppg. San Diego St is used to making this unique trip every other year.

### Monday, December 26th

#### Quick Lane Bowl in Detroit, MI

**1★ New Mex St (+3.5).** † Bowling Green 26 New Mexico St 24. Both teams should be excited to be here with NMSt making their 2nd bowl game since 1960 and BG making their first bowl trip since 2015. NMSt is much better in the stats including ypp margin (+0.7 vs -0.8) but BG does have a big strength of schedule edge (No. 91 vs No. 131). After a 1-5 start, New Mexico St won 5 of their last 6 (also 5-1 ATS) but 2 came vs FCS teams. We bet BG +1 on the openers but would lean with New Mexico St now at +3.5 (we bet numbers, not teams). BG was 0-3 ATS as a favorite.

**Tuesday, December 27th**

**Camellia Bowl in Montgomery, AL**

**2★ Georgia Southern (-3.5).** † **Georgia Southern 36 Buffalo 30.** The best unit on the field is GS's offense as they rank No 18 in total, No. 37 in ypp and No. 30 in scoring. GS QB Kyle Vantrease played 5 years in Buffalo before transferring and should be extra motivated. Meanwhile, Buffalo is -1.1 in ypp margin (No. 119). The Bulls limped to the finish (0-4 ATS). With everything to play for and at home last two games, they blew a big 4Q lead vs Kent St and should have lost to Akron outright as a double-digit favorite. Overall, we think the Sun Belt is better than the MAC and GS has a large strength of schedule edge (No. 84 vs No. 120). GS head coach Clay Helton also has the experience edge vs Maurice Linguist.

**First Responder Bowl in Dallas, TX**

**1★ Memphis (-7.5).** † **Memphis 35 Utah St 26.** Memphis has a massive stat edge here as they were +0.5 in ypp margin (No. 54) vs Utah St's -0.88 (No. 112). Utah St was also -34 ypg and -7.3 ppg this year. Utah St will be without their best player on offense in RB Calvin Tyler (1,043 yards). Memphis was a little bit better than their record indicated as they were 0-4 in one possession games while Utah St was fortunate at 4-0 in close games. We originally leaned with Utah St but diving further into this one, we think Memphis is the right side.

**Birmingham Bowl in Birmingham, AL**

**1★ East Carolina (-7.5).** † **East Carolina 35 Coastal Carolina 26.** This will be the last game at Coastal Carolina for QB Grayson McCall (transfer portal) who has won the Sun Belt player of the year 3 straight years. Generally speaking, we think Coastal is overrated as they were out-gained on the season and out-scored despite a 9-3 record. They are -0.34 in ypp margin (No. 94) while East Carolina was +0.42 (No. 57) despite playing a tougher schedule. This will be the final game for ECU QB Holton Ahlers. Coastal has an interim coach in DC Chad Staggs and saw a few starters opt out including their All-SBC center and their best pass rusher.

**Guaranteed Rate Bowl in Phoenix, AZ**

**1★ UNDER 43.** † **Wisconsin 22 Oklahoma St 19.** Huge edges in the stats for Wisconsin as the Badgers are +0.96 in ypp margin (No. 28) vs Oklahoma St -0.47 (No. 99). Wisconsin was also +57 ypg (No. 38) vs Oklahoma St's -25 ypg (No. 93). The best unit on the field is Wisconsin's defense that ranks No. 13 in total D and No. 16 in defensive ypp. With that being said, we have a ton of uncertainty here. Both teams will be playing with a backup QB. Oklahoma St QB Spencer Sanders is obviously worth more than Wisconsin QB Graham Mertz. In addition to that, Oklahoma St's leading rusher is also out and both teams lost several starters on defense to opt out. Mike Gundy has a huge experience edge over Jim Leonhard coaching his final game as interim. We lean UNDER as each of Wisconsin's last 3 games had lower totals than this. Meanwhile, Oklahoma St had 5 straight UNDERS to close the season.

**Wednesday, December 28th**

**Military Bowl in Annapolis, MD**

**1★ Duke (-3).** † **Duke 32 Central Florida 28.** We've upgraded Duke more in our power ratings than any team in the country this year and if they meet or exceed expectations here, it will be the biggest upgrade for any team in the last 8 seasons. Head coach Mike Elko did an amazing job in year one. The Blue Devils are led by Qb Riley Leonard who had a 20-6 ratio and also led the team in rushing (635 yards and 11 TD's). UCF had the better stats and played the tougher schedule (No. 72 vs No. 78). However, how much do they want to be here? The Knights have had multiple opt outs including WR O'Keefe and we're hearing whispers that QB John Rhys-Plumlee is not 100%.

**Liberty Bowl in Memphis, TN**

**1★ Kansas (+3).** † **Arkansas 35 Kansas 33.** Kansas is making their first bowl appearance since 2008 and should be sky-high. They are better in ypp margin +1.05 vs Arkansas' -0.25 and the two teams played similar strength of schedules. We're not sure how excited Arkansas is for this game. They've lost several starters including a pair of WR's, their All-SEC center Ricky Stromberg, All-SEC LB Drew Sanders, LB Bumper Pool and safety Myles Slusher. DC Barry Odom left to take the UNLV job. We originally leaned Arkansas here as Kansas lost 5 of their last 6 games by double-digits. However, with all the Arkansas opt outs, it's Rock Chalk Jayhawk.

**Holiday Bowl in San Diego, CA**

**1★ North Carolina (+14.5).** † **Oregon 44 North Carolina 30.** Obviously, Oregon has the stat edges including +1.05 in ypp margin vs NC's +0.27. The Ducks started the season 8-1 and were thinking CFB Playoff but lost 2 of their last 3 games and their OC Kenny Dillingham to Arizona St. Meanwhile, the Tar Heels started the season 9-1 thanks to a 6-0 record in one possession games. However, they lost their last 3 games and suffered massive losses to opt outs including WR Josh Downs and three of their starters in the secondary. OC Phil Longo is off to Wisconsin. Both teams did get the good news that their starting QB's will return in 2023 in Bo Nix and Drake Maye. A lot of money has come in on Oregon (we bet them -11.5) but it is too expensive now for our liking now as the back-door could be wide-open in a high scoring game.

**Texas Bowl in Houston, TX**

**1★ Texas Tech (+3.5).** † **Ole Miss 36 Texas Tech 33.** Ole Miss has a huge edge in ypp margin at +1.12 (No. 19) vs Texas Tech's -0.32 (No. 91). Ole Miss did lose 4 of their last 5 games after a 7-0 start vs a weak schedule. Meanwhile, Texas Tech exceeded expectations in year one under Joey McGuire. That's despite the fact they had 3 different QB's attempt 100-plus passes this year. We do expect Tyler Shough to be the QB here. One worry is a Texas Tech defense that allowed more than 200 rush yards in 4 of their last 5 games vs an Ole Miss rush that averages 262 rush ypg. However, Texas Tech should have the crowd edge and Ole Miss' defense we think is overrated due to that early soft schedule.

**FAQ: How do I play your star-rated picks in the bowl issue(s)?**

First, we will admit that most of the 1-star plays would not be included in a regular season issue as they are leans only. However, most of you will want action on every single bowl game for a variety of reasons and that is why we put a star-rated pick on every bowl game whether it is the side or the total. If you are someone that only likes to take part in a few games each week, then we would recommend you only play the 3-star and 4-star picks as they are clearly the strongest. If you are someone that likes to play 5-6 games a week, then the 2-stars are certainly worth your while.

**Week 17 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game**

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 45-38-2. Keep in mind, these computer lines are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage. The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

**HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**1★ N.Y. JETS 20 Jacksonville 17.** Both teams had dramatic finishes with different outcomes last week. Jacksonville got the walk-off interception return TD in OT to upset Dallas while the Jets playoff hopes took a huge hit with their loss to the Lions. The Jets are better in ypp margin and have played the tougher schedule. Jacksonville is on a short week, after an emotional OT win. We like the home team. Note there's some wind and rain in the forecast.

**Saturday, December 24th**

**MINNESOTA 25 N.Y. Giants 22.** Arguably the two most over-rated teams in the NFL. Minnesota is off the historic comeback win over Indianapolis erasing a 33-point deficit (largest in NFL history). Meanwhile, the Giants lost the yardage battle 387-288 and were -2.1 in ypp and yet still upset the Commanders on SNF much to our dismay on these pages. These two teams have a combined 19-8-1 record but Minnesota is No. 25 in ypp margin and the Giants are No. 28. DVOA ranks the two teams No. 22 and No. 25 in their overall rankings. We would like to fade both teams.

**CLEVELAND 18 New Orleans 14.** Cleveland has seen each of their last 4 games go UNDER and New Orleans has seen each of their last 3 go UNDER. Some really nasty weather is in the forecast here (26 mph wind and 8 degree temps). This is the lowest total in any NFL game since 2006! You can throw out a lot of the stats. Cleveland is better suited to win the line of scrimmage in those kind of conditions and we could see something similar to their win over Baltimore last week.

**Detroit 22 CAROLINA 21.** Detroit is one of the hottest teams in the NFL right now with 7 straight covers while winning 6 of those 7 games outright. With winnable games down the stretch, the playoffs are a realistic possibility. That's shocking considering they were 1-6 on November 1st. Carolina has also played well covering 6 of their last 8 games. It's tough laying points on the road here though with Detroit (first time it's happened this season). We lean Carolina especially in a teaser. Note it's going to be 20 degrees in Charlotte on Sunday!

**Cincinnati 22 NEW ENGLAND 20.** How do you comeback from that type of loss that New England just suffered? Not only blowing the lead in the final minute but then orchestrating one of the dumbest plays in football history on the final play. Of course, we came up on the losing end of such shenanigans. Now the Pats play a Cincinnati team that couldn't be any hotter at 11-1 ATS in their last 12 games and will clinch the No. 1 seed in the AFC if they win out. Kickoff forecast is 17 degrees. If a "+3.5" shows we'll be on NE.

**Buffalo 24 CHICAGO 16.** Buffalo was yet another big disappointment on these pages last week as they had to rally to beat the Dolphins after looking like they were in control early. Since the bye, the Bills have been over-priced at 2-6 ATS. Chicago has lost 7 straight games and are just 1-4 ATS in their last 5. The forecast is calling for kickoff temps to be 4 degrees with 20 mph wind. We lean dog and UNDER.

**TENNESSEE 20 Houston 17.** Tennessee has lost 4 straight games (0-3-1 ATS) and their playoff hopes are on fading fast. Houston has clearly not given up on the season as they have nearly pulled outright shocking upsets over Dallas and Kansas City the last two weeks. Temps are going to be in the teens here and we've seen nothing but Houston money in the market especially with Tennessee's QB situation up in the air (Malik Willis could start).

**KANSAS CITY 28 Seattle 20.** Obviously, the Chiefs are one of the best teams in the NFL but they have been over-priced in the market this season covering just 4 of their last 13 games. They find

themselves double-digit favorites here vs a Seattle team that is on a 0-5 ATS run. Do you really want to lay it here with 6-degree kick-off temps and a possible compromised pass attack?

**BALTIMORE 22 Atlanta 15.** There's still some question marks on who will start at QB for the Ravens here. Baltimore is only 3-7 ATS in their last 10 games but still rank a healthy No. 5 in DVOA (which ironically could be a reason they've been overrated in the betting markets). Atlanta is also struggling at 2-6 ATS in their last 8 as Desmond Ridder will get the start for them after going just 13 of 26 for 97 yards last week. Teasing Baltimore down to -1.5 with a very low total sounds good to us.

**SAN FRANCISCO 23 Washington 16.** The 49ers have played one of the weaker schedules in the NFL but they remain red-hot with 7 straight wins (6-1 ATS). The Commanders were red-hot but have dropped back-to-back games ATS vs the Giants including a misleading loss last week (much to our dismay). It's the first game where weather shouldn't be a factor. We're just not that wild about laying 7 with a total of 38.

**DALLAS 26 Philadelphia 21.** A lot of the excitement has been subdued on this one. First, the Cowboys were upset in OT last week. Second, Jalen Hurts will miss this game for the Eagles and Gardner Minschew will get the start. Philly can clinch the No. 1 seed with a win in any of their remaining 3 games. Meanwhile, Dallas is pretty much locked into the No. 5 seed. We were hoping to bet Dallas but not at the current numbers.

**2★ PITTSBURGH 21 Las Vegas 16.** Anytime the Raiders and Steelers play, one thinks back to the Immaculate Reception especially with the news of Franco Harris passing away on Wednesday. We do expect to see a very-charged up crowd here. The Steelers have a huge edge on defense (No. 13 vs No. 32 in DVOA) and have also played the much tougher schedule (No. 2 vs No. 32 in DVOA past schedule). We don't mind fading the Raiders a second straight week after their miracle win last week.

**Sunday, December 25th**

**MIAMI 26 Green Bay 22.** Kudos to Miami for their performance in the cold last week in Buffalo. The Dolphins are No. 5 in ypp margin despite playing Jeff Sagarin's toughest schedule. They're catching Green Bay traveling on a short week. The Packers are an average team and have played an average schedule. We've been all about fading the Dolphins lately (3-7-1 ATS run) but not at this price. We're passing.

**Denver 19 L.A. RAMS 17.** Kudos for the Broncos for not giving up on the season as Denver has covered 3 straight games and broke their 5-game losing streak last week. It's still all defense (No. 4 in DVOA) and no offense (No. 28 in DVOA). The Rams are on a short week and will continue with Baker Mayfield at QB here. We really like the Rams in a teaser here.

**Tampa Bay 23 ARIZONA 17.** The Bucs are the most overrated team in football. Hindsight is always 20/20 but shame on us for not fading them more on these pages. Tampa is now on a 1-10-1 ATS run. Last week's loss to Cincinnati was misleading. We don't think Arizona has much to play for and they could be down to 3rd string Trace McSorley here with McCoy in concussion protocol.

**Monday, December 26th**

**L.A. Chargers 26 INDIANAPOLIS 21.** Breaking news on Wednesday morning is that Nick Foles will get the start for the Colts. We saw the line go from -3.5/-4 to -4.5 so obviously it's not that big of a downgrade. How do the Colts respond after blowing the 33-point lead last Saturday? Meanwhile, the Chargers have won back-to-back key games to regain control of their playoff hopes.
