

Nico Varrone joins Keating, Catsburg for seven-round GTE Am championship

DETROIT (Jan. 13, 2023) – Corvette Racing is completing its lineup for the 2023 FIA World Endurance Championship with young Argentinian driver Nico Varrone joining Ben Keating and factory driver Nicky Catsburg. The trio will team together in the No. 33 Mobil 1/SiriusXM Chevrolet Corvette C8.R in the GTE Am category.

It's the second straight full-season program in the FIA WEC for Corvette Racing, which celebrate its 25th season of competition in 2023. The campaign will be the first for the Corvette program in GTE Am, where the sporting rules require at least one Bronze-level driver, as rated by the FIA. One professional-level driver is allowed along with a second Bronze or Silver-rated driver.

The combination of Catsburg, Keating and Varrone will contest the full seven-race WEC calendar including the 24 Hours of Le Mans in June. The season begins with the 1,000 Miles of Sebring on Friday, March 17.

C8 Z06 LT8 Engine break-in



Do you have one of the early Z06's? Are you getting one soon? If so, it is very important to break it in correctly, and the miles required are different if you are running it on the road vs. the track. The main recommendation about the engine break-in is that the vehicle should not be pushed too hard for the first 500 miles for street driving and 1,500 miles before track use. The car should be driven at varying RPMs and speeds and not pushed to the redline regularly unless necessary. To make this easier for the driver, the digital tachometer will show a 6,600 RPM redline before hitting the 500-mile threshold. Even though the tachometer will show the redline, the engine will allow the owner to push past this.

The Z06's eight-speed dual-clutch transmission also requires a break-in period, and as such, the onboard system reduces engine power for the first 500 miles in the first two gears.

2024 Corvette E-Ray, 655-hp, AWD hybrid is the quickest Vette ever.









Today, 1-23-2023 (exactly 70 years from the historic unveiling of the 1953 C1 at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in NYC), GM officially revealed the 2024 E-Ray and we got to see with our own eyes what was accidentally revealed on their visualizer!

Yes, the new 2024 E-Ray will in fact have the widebody from the Z06. And yes folks, it has been confirmed the Corvette Brand will finally have its first hybrid, with allwheel drive to boot!

This is the first step to what some consider GM's move away from the internal combustion engine for the Corvette. And that move has some truly excited, but some diehard enthusiasts sad for what the next Corvette era will bring.

While not fully an EV, it's confirmed the E-Ray will continue to use the <u>LT2 V8</u> from the Stingray and add electric assist motors on the front axles, effectively making it the brand's first all-wheel drive Corvette.

This setup is now reported to produce 655hp, far above the 495hp from the <u>Z51-equipped Stingray</u>. And all this will come with a base price of \$109,900.

GM Files To Trademark Corvette Grand Sport

GM has filed to trademark the <u>Corvette</u> Grand Sport name, *GM Authority* has learned. The new trademark filing may indicate GM is now interested in offering a new Corvette Grand Sport model for the eighth-generation <u>Chevy Corvette C8</u>, or possibly the next-generation C9.

The new trademark application was filed on May 26th, 2022 with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO), and was assigned serial number 97430541. The application was filed under a Goods and Services category reserved for "motor land vehicles, namely, automobiles, sport utility vehicles, trucks and vans."

General Motors has obviously used the Corvette Grand Sport name throughout the history of the Chevy Corvette, but this recent application is nonetheless a bit strange. As GM Authority reported previously, General Motors was originally not going to offer a Grand Sport variant of the current eighth-generation C8, instead offering the upcoming C8 E-Ray hybrid with regard to the Grand Sport's positioning in the eighth-gen's model lineup.

Of course, it's entirely possible The General has changed course in this respect and *will* offer a new C8 Grand Sport model after all. If such a model were to come about, it would likely couple the naturally aspirated 6.2L V8 LT2 gasoline engine found behind the cabin of the C8 Stingray with the wide-body exterior treatment of the C8 Z06 and E-Ray.

Such a move would certainly make sense from a supply point of view – given the current supply chain environment, specifically, the ongoing global shortage of microchips, a new C8 Corvette Grand Sport could be a less chip-intensive model compared to the hybrid C8 E-Ray.

Another possibility is that this new trademark filing is in preparation for an upcoming Corvette Grand Sport model to be offered with the next-generation Corvette C9.

Check back soon, as we'll continue to follow this story for further updates and will relay whatever we may learn. 




