1. Propitiation.

Definition – Averting God's anger or wrath, which is mentioned nearly 600 times in the Bible, by an offering.

- Romans 3:21-26 "The rationale of God's justification of sinners."
- Hebrews 2:17: "The rationale of the incarnation of the Son of God"
- I John 2:1-2: "The basis of the heavenly ministry of our Lord."
- I John 4:8-10 "The Definition of God's Love."

2. Adoption.

- Romans 8:15 All who are "in Christ Jesus" are declared to be
 "children of God" through adoption.
- Galatians 4:5 Our adoption through our redemption has made us "sons" and heirs.
- Ephesians 1:5 We are chosen in Christ to be holy and blameless
 before Him. He predestined us for adoption as sons of God.

3. Effect

- Shows the greatness of God's love. (I John 3:1)
- Shows the glory of Christian Hope. (Rom. 8:17; Gal. 4:7)
- Helps us understand discipline. (Heb12: 6-7, 11)
- Shows assurance (Rom. 8:29-30; 38-39)
