REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS

We are now able to welcome back a little more normality to our services than we have over the last few weeks, and we look forward to more being able to join us within the Church.

If you enjoy singing this is now permitted and you will be able to mix and engage, if they are willing, with other members of the congregation.

However, we are mindful that not everyone is 100% comfortable with 'no restrictions' so we will be trying to accommodate those that are embracing the removal of restrictions and those that want to take things a bit slower.

We intend to do the following to help with the changes:

Our welcome/door stewards will continue to wear masks to greet you

Hand sanitiser will continue to be available at the door

You are asked to continue to scan the OR code or record your details on the forms provided The windows and doors will continue to be open to provide ventilation

Those not wishing to wear masks and wanting to sing will be asked to sit in the front pews, leaving the first two rows unoccupied

Those wishing to wear masks and/or maintain social distance will be asked to sit in the rear pews

There will currently be no distribution of hymn books or an offertory collection, please continue to give online

At the end of services those at the rear of the Church will be offered to leave first

We want you to feel safe and relaxed, so please let a steward know if there is anything else they can do for you to achieve this when you are in the Church.

IMPORTANT CONSULTATION - REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES - NEW WARD ARRANGEMENTS

Please find the attached notice advising of the forthcoming Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places for the London Borough of Havering. As your premises has been or is currently used as a Polling Station you may wish to take part in the consultation. I would also be grateful if you could display the attached notice in order to advertise the review to your service users.

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has undertaken an Electoral Review of the London Borough of Havering ward arrangements. There will be an increase of Wards from 18 to 20, which results in changes to the current ward boundaries and the Polling Districts within them.

Therefore, Havering is undertaking a review of its polling districts and also the location of polling places/stations for use at both national and local elections to mirror the changes to the ward boundaries.

The changes to the Wards and Polling Districts will be used at the Local Council Elections on 5 May 2022.

We are launching a consultation on Polling Districts and Polling places/stations starting on 19th July 2021 and closing on 13th August 2021.
