<u>School Supplies</u>: The required school supply list for all grades is posted on the school website. Please send your child's supplies with them on the first day of school.

<u>School Messenger</u>: If you would like to change or add family email addresses or phone numbers to our Schoolreach parent notification system, please email the info to the School Office.

<u>Tuition Incentive Program:</u> For every new family you refer that enrolls at OLSS and designates you as their referring family, you will receive \$500 off your tuition.

<u>Virtus Program</u>: All family members who would like to volunteer at the school must first complete all steps of the Archdiocese of Washington's Virtus Child Protection Program. Info & forms are available from the School Office.
