

COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT

All coaches must abide by this Code of Conduct to ensure that their behaviour and actions meet the values and standards expected of them.

- Consider the well-being and safety of participants and ensure all health and safety procedures and policies and safeguarding guidelines are adhered to throughout the session.
- Promote and adhere to the positive aspects of the sport (e.g fair play) and show respect for fellow coaches, players, match officials, volunteers, and opposing players.
- Demonstrate professional behaviour, be a positive role model and not abuse any relationship of trust or position of power within the club.
- Provide a planned and structured training programme that is appropriate to the needs and goals of the players ensuring that all players have equal attention and opportunities.
- Demonstrate the ability to accept success and failure, victory and defeat equally in a positive manner.
- Be proactive in continuing their professional development
- Follow all guidelines laid down by England Netball and the club
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover

Coaches will not:

- Consume alcohol, illegal substances or smoke around players or be under the influence when coaching.
- Disclose any confidential information with prior consent from parents or players except in exceptional circumstances
- Use social media to make inappropriate comments about the club, its players, fellow coaches or officials.
