

In order to do well on the test, be sure you can:

- Identify common and proper nouns in a sentence.
- Change singular nouns to plural, and plural nouns to singular
- Show possession with correct use of apostrophe
- Identify the four types of sentences and correctly punctuate them.
- Identify incomplete and complete sentences and punctuate correctly.
- Identify simple and complete subjects
- Identify simple and complete predicates
- Use subject and object pronouns correctly.
- Match vocabulary words from notebook and notes with their definitions.
- Distinguish between biography and autobiography

In addition to the above, the children will have two short, non fiction passages to read and answer questions over.

The children should have their grammar work and notes in their big binder and their vocabulary is in a composition notebook which they should bring home to study for the test.
