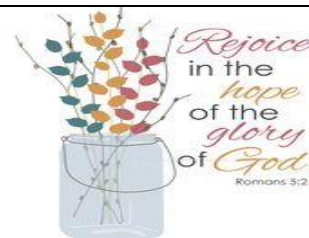

Third Sunday of Easter

John 21:1-19

“Children, have you caught anything to eat.”

After Thomas proclaimed “My Lord and my God” in the upper room in Jerusalem, Jesus appeared to Thomas and six other disciples on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias [Galilee]. Jesus called them *Children*. In light of their actions in the Garden of Gethsemane, at the House of Caiaphas, and their absence at the foot of the cross, Jesus might have called them something else. But Jesus was not berating them. Neither should we. The disciples heard Jesus and saw miraculous things. They also saw people brutally beaten and crucified by the Romans, and lived under the domination of Jewish leaders. When Jesus was arrested they were fearful. Despite all they had heard and seen, their faith was childlike - not strong and mature. When Jesus calls the disciples *Children* He is saying “I love you like a parent, despite your faults and failings.” He was also saying, “You have much to learn.” If we hear Jesus call us *Children*, do we realize He is saying “I love you very much, but you have much to learn”? How will we respond?
